
Create a design

- 1. Click (Top right)
- 2. Type Instagram Post, and press enter. We have found an Instagram post is a good size for print design, 1080 x 1080
- 3. Save your work give the project a title Eg Print-tile1



- 4. Click uploads You can then upload your own media (photos and illustrations)
- 5. Wait for your image to upload.

6. Select the image you want to use by tapping it.

If any photo of illustration has a watermark on it- it isn't a FREE image!

Here you can **apply different filters**, enhance the image or remove the background.

Click on the effect you would like. Our favourite effect is the background remover tool.





8. At this stage you should also consider the **size, angle & positioning of the image**. Maybe you would like to rotate the image? Flip it? Move it?

9. When you are happy with the motif, duplicate it.


10. Click and drag one image so that it extends beyond your canvas



11. Click and drag the other image directly opposite it.

12. Canva naturally wants to help you align your work. Take note of the lines / shapes it produces on your screen to show you when the two images are perfectly aligned.



14. **Now repeat adding more images.** Remember to insert the image, edit it and then place it where you would like it.

15. Not all images should extend beyond the canvas - but it is good to have a few.

16. Every time you place an image so that it extends beyond the canvas you must duplicate it, and place it on the opposite side of the canvas.

17. When you have finished **download** your work.
