Regarding the definition of "diverse" in "diverse set of consumers" that this definition include regional and remote energy consumers (businesses and individuals).

Similarly that AEMC ensures "Consumer groups and advocates" includes small and large businesses, set of consumer preference principles" to be interested include representatives of remote and regional business energy users.

Furthermore, AEMC consider 'vulnerable' to include rural and regional community energy consumers who are vulnerable to climate events affecting their income - horticulture and agribusiness, associated food, fibre and foliage producers as well as regional businesses reliant on tourism and providing accommodation and facilities.
